Successful completion of one or two geoscience courses strongly recommended.)

LIBERAL ARTS

ALL: Must be in good standing with intended major; check with department

2.75 COMM/TCMS

2.50 INTS less than 45 hours, prefer some foreign language

2.00 ECON Must have ECON202, ECON203 & Math 141 or 166 complete with Cs or better

2.00 POLS Must have both POLS 206 & 207 complete, no more than 75 hours

2.25 PSYC Must have PSYC 107 completed w/ C or better, no more than 75 hours

Prefer MATH 141 or 166 completed

2.00 MUSC Must audition to be accepted

SCIENCE

(go to individual departments)

CHEM: Complete CHEM 101/111, CHEM 102/112, and Math 151 or Math 171 with C's or better and be registered for or enrolled in Math 152 or Math 172

2.50 cumulative and in CHEM and MATH courses/ No D's or F's in major / no scholastic dishonesty

BIOL, BMCB, MBIO & ZOOL: Complete one semester of Biology with C or better

2.50 cumulative and in proposed major / No D's or F's in major / no scholastic dishonesty

MATH & APMS: Complete Math 151 or 171 w/ C's or better. If math is taken at a community college, Math 151 or 171 and Math 152 or 172 must be completed prior to change of major

2.50 cumulative and in proposed major / No D's or F's in major / no scholastic dishonesty

PHYS: Complete PHYS 218 and Math 151 or 171 with C's or better

2.50 cumulative and in proposed major / No D's or F's in major / no scholastic dishonesty

VETERINARY MED. (Biomedical Science)

(go to VMA 81)

2.50 on at least 12 hours at TAMU. Prefer less than 75 hours. Must have all CBKs complete with a C or better.

CBKs taken somewhere other than TAMU must be completed with a B or better.

(CBKs: CHEM 101/111, 102/112, 227, 237, 228, 238, PHYS 201, 202, BIOL 111,112, MATH 131).
