 ♦Business majors must choose from specific PSYC, SOCI, ANTH, or WMST courses (Management and Marketing majors must take PSYC 107)
 ♦Education majors have limited choices and should carefully check catalog
 ♦Construction Science requires ECON 202
 ♦Carefully check Construction Science in Catalog
 ♦Carefully check Landscape Architecture in Catalog
 ♥Landscape Architecture requires LAND 240
 ♦If MODL is used for this requirement, it must be in a different language than taken in high school, or, if in the same language, at the 200-level or higher
 ♦Engineering requires ENGR 482, Ethics and Engineering. Carefully check Catalog
 ♦Landscape Architecture requires ENDS 150
